#### Item 2. Establishment of an endowed fund in the Tyler School of Art and Architecture

Ms. Burke explained the request for permission to establish an endowed fund with a pledge of \$540,000 over a three-year period. The fud will provide financial support to students majoring in photography. Following discussion, the committee agreed with the recommendation.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Alumni Relations and Development Committee, upon the recommendation of the Gift Acceptance Committee (6/6/2022), recommend that the Board of Trustees\_approve the establishment of an endowed fund in the Tyler School of Art and Architecture.

# Item 3a. Named Space in the Tyler School of Art and Architecture

Ms. Burke explained the request for approval to accept a gift of \$200,00 from alum Edgar Heap of Birds. Following discussion, the committee agreed with the recommendation.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Alumni Relations and Development Committee, upon the recommendation of the Gift Acceptance Committee (6/6/2022), recommend that the Board of Trustees\_approve the naming of gallery space in the Tyler School of Art and Architecture.

# <u>Item 3b. Named Space in the Beasley School of Law</u>

Ms. Burke explained the request for permission to accept a pledge of \$120,000 from the Beasley Firm, LLC, payable over five-years to support the school's trial advocacy program. Following discussion, the committee agreed with the recommendation.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Alumni Relations and Development Committee, upon the recommendation of the Gift Acceptance Committee (6/6/2022), recommend that the Board of Trustees approve the naming of a classroom in the Beasley School of Law.
