**Title:** Nondiscriminatory Policy as to Students

**Policy**

WHEREAS, Temple University - Of The Commonwealth System of Higher Educational has traditionally followed a practice of Nondiscrimination as to Students; and

WHEREAS, Revenue Procedure 75-50 of the Internal Revenue Service requires that a Nondiscriminatory Policy as to Students be adopted by the governing body of an educational institution,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Executive Committee, acting on behalf of the Board of Trustees of Temple University - Of The Commonwealth System of Higher Education affirms that the University admits the students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the University; and, further, that the University does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school-administered programs.
